Purpose of the Job

The role of Disability Outreach Worker is vital to the successful delivery of quality programmes and services in NCHMS for our clients. The Disability Outreach Worker will support the clients of NOVAS Disability & Young Persons Services in Kerry.

The Disability Outreach Worker will report directly to the Deputy Manager, will be a member of, and work collaboratively with the wider staff team, wider NCHMS services, external service providers and local authorities in the region. The Disability Outreach Worker is responsible for supporting clients, sourcing housing options for clients where appropriate, supporting clients to move into and sustain their accommodation for a period of time. The Disability Outreach Worker will ensure effective day to day running of the project, all aspects of health and safety, hygiene and physical environment is kept to a high standard at times. The Disability Outreach Worker need to carry clients in their own vehicles as well as having use of company vehicles at times.

This role may include day and evening work (8 hour shifts), weekend work (4/8 hour shifts).

The Disability Outreach Worker will have a background in Social Care, minimum level 2, with training or experience in the areas of Homeless and/or Young Persons Services and will be expected to work within the relevant frameworks of quality standards or legislation.
