Purpose of the Job

The role of Night Safety Attendant is vital to the successful delivery of quality programmes and services in NOVAS for our clients. The Night Safety Attendant will support the clients of the Whitestown SIA, however subject to change to another Novas Dublin service.

The Night Safety Attendant will report directly to the Whitestown Service Manager, will be a member of, and work collaboratively with the Whitestown staff team, under NOVAS services, external service providers and local authorities in the region. The Night Safety Attendant is responsible for live night cover, supporting clients, monitoring client wellbeing, liaising with client key workers, responding and managing any incidents that arise during the night. The Night Safety Attendant will ensure effective running of the project during the night, all aspects of health and safety, the hygiene and physical environment is kept to a high standard at times.

The role is situated in the Whitestown but subject to change to another NOVAS Dublin service. This role consists of 12-hour night shifts including weekends.

The Night Safety Attendant will have a background in Social Care, minimum level 5, with training or experience in the areas of Homeless Services and will be expected to work within the relevant frameworks of quality standards or legislation.

This job description is a guide to the general range of duties assigned to the post holder. It is intended to be neither definitive nor restrictive and is subject to periodic review.
